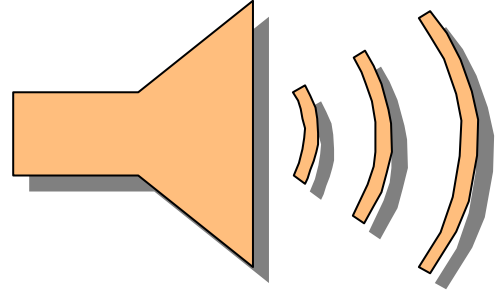


HIGH SCHOOL ANNOUNCEMENTS

GENERAL:

- We will be running on an early dismissal schedule in order to administer final exams.

- Student drivers: Please return your parking passes to the Activities Office. If your pass is not returned, you will be placed on the obligation list.

- Juniors: Early this week, a mailing was sent to your house concerning the senior picture process for the Class of 2018. Please be sure you complete the questionnaire and return it to the Activities Office before you leave for summer vacation.
- Underclassmen: If you did not turn in your iPad, please take it to the auditorium. Prices for failing to turn in iPad and accessories are as follows:
