

Kindergarten Supply List 2018-2019

- Crayola-brand crayons; 4 boxes to be used throughout the year (no larger than 24-pack)
- Glue sticks; at least 8 (preferred: Elmer's brand)
- Pencil pouch (as pictured below)
- Highlighters (1-2)
- Dry erase markers (1-2) (preferred: Expo brand)
- Lunch Box (if packing lunches)
- Thermos-style water bottle
- Backpack large enough to fit folders, art projects, etc. Please make sure that backpacks do not have wheels!

Please label all of your child's supplies!



Other items that are not necessities, but are appreciated by your child's teacher:

- Tissues
- Crayola markers
- Hand sanitizer
- Napkins (for snack)
- Plastic spoons (for snack)
- Paper towels
- Ziploc bags (various sizes: quart & gallon)
- Pencils (#2 without decorations)
- Baby wipes

- Pencil Box
- Scissors (student sized)
- Several Pencils (not mechanical)
- Box of 24 crayons (not a larger box than this)
- Highlighter
- Pink Erasers
- Ear Buds or Headphones (labeled with your child's name & in a bag, please)
- Art Shirt (labeled with your child's name)
- Glue Sticks
- 2 Boxes of Tissues
- 1 tub of antibacterial wipes
- 1 pack of Low Odor dry erase markers (black or blue, please)

Suggested Supplies for Second Grade



- 1 pair of headphone ear buds or earphones (for laptops/CPU Lab...can be found at dollar stores or Five Below store) **Please take earbuds/earphones out of package and place in pencil pouch.**
- 2 Soft pencil pouches (1 for pencils, 1 to store ear buds in)
- 1 One subject notebook
- Pencils (any yellow number 2 pencil)
- Glue Sticks
- 2 Extra Large book covers (cloth-stretchable)
- 2 Boxes of tissues
- 1 Tub of antibacterial wipes

3rd Grade Supply List

Dear NEW 3rd Grade Scott Primary Families,

Welcome to 2018- 2019 3rd grade! Third grade is a year of great learning and growth! We are very excited and can't wait to have a great year. Many times, families like to prepare for the upcoming school year and often the sales are in July and August. In case some of the sales were being taken advantage of, here are some items needed for the upcoming school year:

- Durable backpack (no wheels - won't fit in lockers) Labeled with name
- Lunch bag/Lunchbox- labeled with name
- 1 soft shell nylon or box pencil case, no larger than 8in x 4 inches. This should lay flat and fit easily inside of a desk.
- 1 set of ear buds(headphones) and case
- 1 Pair of scissors (Fiskars last the longest)
- 1 box of 8-12 COUNT sharpened colored pencils **OR** 1 box of 8-12 COUNT crayons **OR** 1 box of 8-12 COUNT twistable crayons. (All 3 are not needed- one only for coloring purposes)
- 1 Dry Erase Marker and sock eraser (an old clean sock)
- 2 Glue sticks (Elmer's preferable)
- 1 pink rectangular eraser (not a pencil top, but the rectangular eraser)
- A pack of Ticonderoga sharpened pencils (to share with the class)
- 1 highlighter

IMPORTANT: Please label all supplies with your child's name. This includes pencils, dry erase markers, pencil case—everything! All should be labeled.

The following items **MUST** fit inside the pencil case: scissors, crayons OR pencils (only one is needed), glue sticks, highlighter, dry erase marker/ sock eraser, 2 pencils, and pink eraser. Anything that is sent in **EXTRA WILL BE PLACED** inside a **COMMON CLASSROOM** drawer, which means it is available for **ALL** students to use. In the previous years, there has been an overabundance of materials brought into the classroom. If extra materials or items are purchased, please leave them at home for when your child needs them.

As items are needed, such as Kleenex, Clorox wipes, paper towels, etc, teachers will normally put in a request through email, newsletter, or classroom communication. We ask that materials are **NOT** sent into school unless requested by the teacher.
