810.1 DRUG / ALCOHOL TESTING – COVERED DRIVERS

1. Purpose The Board recognizes that the use and abuse of drugs and alcohol is a serious problem that may be present in the workplace. The Board also recognizes that a covered driver impaired by drugs or alcohol who operates school buses or vehicles or transports students poses significant risks to the safety of students and others.

Authority

A covered driver shall include any district employee who drives, operates, or is in the actual physical control or movement of a school bus, school vehicle, or a commercial vehicle owned, leased, or operated by the school district. The term includes drivers and mechanics who operate such vehicles, including full-time, regularly employed individuals; leased drivers; and independent owner-operator contractors who are directly employed by or under lease to the district or who operate a bus owned or leased by the district.

The Board establishes that all contracted transportation providers shall provide a program of drug and alcohol testing for covered drivers. A statement ensuring such program shall be included in the contracted agreement.
