

7th and 8th grade course offerings are designed for student exploration. Courses are offered to all students in the core subject areas of English Language Arts, Mathematics, Science, Social Studies, and Physical Education. However, to maximize the middle school experience, students are exposed to the Arts, Music, Computers, Foundations, Family and Consumer Science, Technology Education, STEM and World Language. These middle school years are for discovery as our students journey towards a career path and the rigors of the high school curriculum.

REQUIRED COURSES

7th grade students will take each of the following courses

ENGLISH LANGUAGE ARTS 7

The seventh grade English Language Arts program is designed to further students' communication skills. The course is two periods of English Language Arts (ELA). This course has a strong emphasis placed on building skills in grammar, vocabulary, speaking, listening, writing, and reading.

LIFE SCIENCE 7

The course begins by reviewing the basic nature of science and moves into the characteristics of living things.

ANCIENT EMPIRES 7

This course is a survey of world history from the time of the Roman Empire until the Late Middle Ages.

MATHEMATICS (1 of 3 offerings)

- MATH 7
 - Prerequisites: Math 6, or Accelerated Math 6 students who do not meet the standards on the scoring rubric to move on to Accelerated Math 7 or Algebra 1 7.

ACCELERATED MATH 7

 Prerequisites: A rubric score consisting of final grade in Math 6, STAR Assessment, PSSA scores (when available), and teacher recommendation, or Accelerated Math 6 students who do not meet the standards on the scoring rubric to move on to Algebra 17

ALGEBRA I 7

 Prerequisites: A rubric score consisting of final grade in Accelerated Math 6, STAR Assessment, PSSA scores (when available), and teacher recommendation.

EXPLORATORY ARTS 7

Nine-week Rotations

All 7th grade students will take each of the following for a nine-week period

- VISUAL ARTS (9-weeks, every day)
- FAMILY AND CONSUMER SCIENCE (9-weeks, every day)
- COMPUTERS 7 (9-weeks, every day)
- STEM 7: Science, Technology, Engineering, and Mathematics (9-weeks, every day)

EXPERIENTIAL COURSE OFFERINGS

Students in Resource Class will not participate in the courses below

• FOUNDATIONS 7

(Full year course, every other day)
Foundations is a course to prepare children as they transition to middle school.
Students will learn study skills, organization, time management and the necessary requisites to be a successful student.

• WORLD LANGUAGE EXPLORATION (Full year course, every other day)
Students will EXPLORE the four World Languages offered at Shaler Area High School: Spanish, Latin, Japanese and French. This exploratory rotation will provide students with a basic exposure to introductory vocabulary in each of languages.

PHYSICAL EDUCATION 7

(Full year course, *every other day*) Meets opposite your elective
