

Kindergarten Quick Facts

- Scott Primary is a K-3 setting and currently has about 400 students enrolled.
- Student arrival time is 8:45 a.m. Car morning drop off is on the side of the school. Follow signage.
- School officially begins at 9:00 a.m. and ends at 3:30 p.m.
- **All late arrivals must have an adult escort the child into the main office and sign them into the building.**
- Students follow a six day rotation.
- In a six day rotation, students will have two art, two music, and two physical education classes.
- Students do not change clothes for physical education class but should always wear safe shoes to school.
- Students should bring a snack each day. Please pack it separately from your child's lunch to avoid confusion. **Do not send in peanut butter or nut based snacks.**
- Students are assigned to a bus waiting area at the end of the day dismissal.
- Walkers/riders are dismissed from the cafeteria exit. Please send a note if your child is a walker/rider. Scott Primary parents should arrive at 3:25 p.m. at the cafeteria lot and remain in their cars. Teachers will bring students to the cars. Students will be dismissed at 3:30 p.m.
- Please put your child's name in their lunch boxes, coats and any personal belongings. All lost and found items will be placed in the Cafeteria.

Scott Parent Teacher Organization

The Scott Parent Teacher Organization is a vital part of our school. The SPTO is lead by an executive committee and depends on our school community to take an active role in supporting school activities. Frequently Asked Questions:

When will we know who our teachers will be?

Letters notifying students of their teachers and home-room assignment are sent out in the month of August.

Can I request a specific teacher for my child and/or a certain classmate?

There is an extreme effort to keep classes balanced based on gender, academic achievement, ability, and specific needs of students. We cannot fulfill requests.

When will we get our bus information?

Bus information is mailed during the month of August from the District Transportation Department.

Is there before/after school care available for my child?

The Boys and Girls Club will be providing before/after school care for students in our building. What is the first day of school for kindergarten students?

Kindergarten students along with a parents will begin with an abbreviated day on Tuesday, August 25th. **Our newest students will be introduced to school the day before all students return.** Scott Primary students will attend from 9:30-10:30 a.m. Transportation is not provided to school that day. Students will attend a bus orientation at school and have the opportunity to ride the school bus with their classmates. August 26th will be the first full day of school. Transportation will begin on August 26.
