

# **SHALER AREA HIGH SCHOOL - IN-HOUSE SCHOLARSHIPS**

- Only apply for scholarships in which you meet the qualifications - don't apply "just because"
  - If you do not meet the required qualifications of a scholarship, your application will NOT be considered
  - Scholarship committees perceive this as inconsiderate and/or wasteful of both their time and yours
- Include all required documentation (letters of recommendations, financial information, essays, etc.)
  - Many applications WILL NOT and CANNOT be considered by the various scholarship committees because you did not include all the required documentation
- Be sure to request transcripts at least 2 weeks in advance
  - The link for the form can be found on the Counseling Office webpage and their Google Classroom
  - After you complete this form, you will receive a PDF to use for any scholarship that requires a transcript.
- Hand in completed application to the Counseling Office by the advertised and posted deadlines
  - Late applications are unable to be accepted
