For instance, at our recent Trunk or Treat event, we had only 35 volunteers despite having 185 SPTO member families, and over 300+ kids (with a total of 700+ participants) signed up for the event.

A dedicated group of volunteers has been carrying most of the workload throughout the school year. To balance this load and enhance our school events, we need more families to get involved. It only takes a small amount of your time, even just half an hour, to make a significant impact at many of our events.

To ensure the success of future events and offer a wider range of activities, we require greater participation from our school families. Without adequate volunteer support, we may regrettably have to cancel upcoming events. We've also been considering a policy that could make volunteering a requirement for participating in high-demand activities like field day, but we'd prefer to see increased participation without such a stipulation.

We've received inquiries about whether grandparents can volunteer, and the answer is yes! Your SPTO membership covers your entire family, including grandparents, so they are more than welcome to volunteer without needing a separate SPTO membership registration.

We do want to express our heartfelt gratitude to those who have consistently volunteered. Your dedication and hard work have not gone unnoticed. It's thanks to your commitment that we can continue providing these valuable experiences for our children.
