Additional details and factors determining if the absence will be approved may be found in School Board Policy 204.1. Students with poor academic records and/or poor attendance will not be considered. **Trips will NOT be approved during critical testing periods or the last two weeks of the school year.**

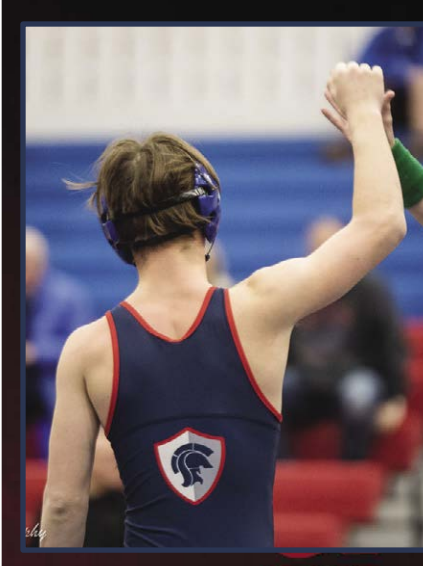

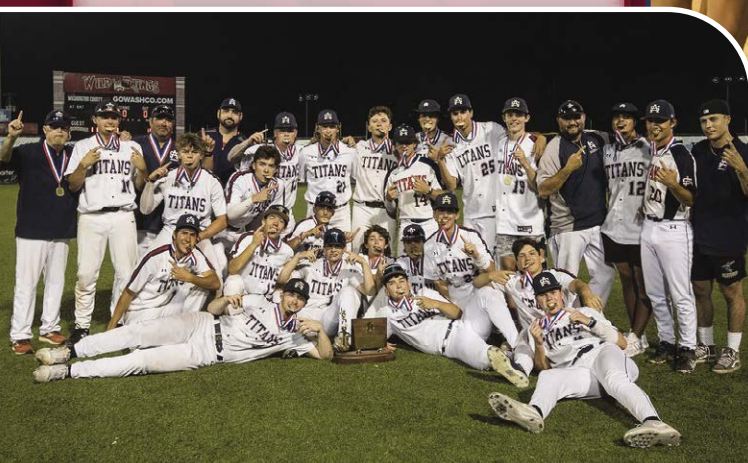

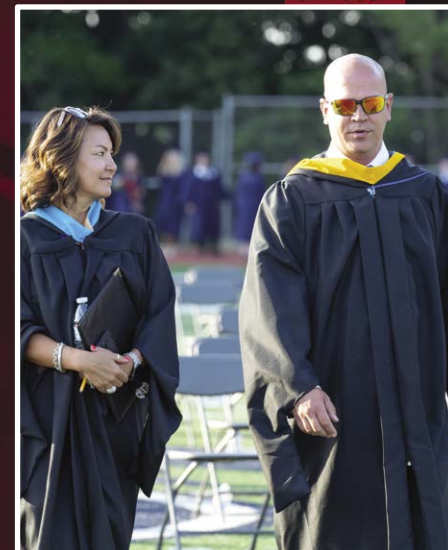
WHAT ARE THE KEYSTONE EXAMINATIONS?
