Directions:

- 1.) Color and cut out the tennis shoe pattern.
- 2.) Poke holes in the eyelets as marked where the shoelaces go.
- 3.) Lace yarn, rope, or shoelace through the holes and practice tying your shoe.
- 4.) Return your shoe, with your name and homeroom on the back to your PE teacher to display in the halls. Return by the end of the month.
