
HIGH SCHOOL ANNOUNCEMENTS

GUIDANCE:

- ➤ Shaler Area School District is now accepting applications for its student summer employment program. This job entails working with the custodians and maintenance employees to prepare the schools for the next school year. Example work tasks include cleaning, scrubbing, waxing floors, repairing furniture and buildings, moving equipment and supplies, and working on the school grounds outside. This job opportunity is for students 16 or older by June 2nd who are able to work Monday through Friday early morning through late afternoon. For an application, please stop by the Guidance Office.
- ➤ Applications for the Theater Arts Parents of Shaler (T.A.P.S) Scholarships are now available in the Guidance Office. This is an opportunity for SAHS seniors with a minimum of two years participation (cast, crew, or orchestra) in a musical and/or play during his/her four years at SAHS. Deadline for submission is Tuesday March 28th, 2017 (no late applications will be accepted).
- Applications for the Bill and Sue Suit Shaler Area Athletic Hall of Fame Memorial Scholarship are now available in the Counseling Office. This \$500 scholarship is for a varsity athlete who has lettered in his/her senior season and has achieved excellence in the categories of academic success, community service, and personal character. Completed applications must be turned into the Counseling Office on or before April 11, 2017.
- ➤ The Freddie Fu Sports Medicine Scholarship Program is accepting applications. This is an opportunity for current <u>juniors</u>. Selected students complete a six-week long physical therapy internship during the summer at UPMC Rooney Sports Complex and UPMC Lemieux Sports Complex. A \$2,000 scholarship is awarded to one of the program participants. The application must be completed online, printed out, and submitted by mail. Two letters of recommendation and a school counselor signature are also required. The application must be postmarked by April 22nd.
