Notice from Dr. Howard for ALL STUDENTS

Water bottles - Students may not carry water bottles (or similar items) to classes. Any exceptions to this rule must be approved by the administration (ex: during extreme heat or for medical conditions).

Backpacks –Students should not carry their backpacks to classes. Students may only bring a backpack to last period with the permission of the last period teacher so that the student will not miss the bus.
